

Principle Of Security Managemen

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The management of security risks applies the principles of risk management to the management of security threats. It consists of identifying threats (or risk causes), assessing the effectiveness of existing controls to face those threats, determining the risks' consequence(s), prioritizing the risks by rating the likelihood and impact, classifying the type of risk, and selecting an appropriate risk option or risk response.

A good general security principle is "defense in depth"; you should have numerous defense mechanisms ("layers") in place, designed so that an attacker has to defeat multiple mechanisms to perform a successful attack.

Security Principles

Encryption keys can be used throughout the application stack to encrypt data within the user interface, within the client, within middle tiers as well as databases, tapes, and SANs. A key manager allows management of a sufficient number of keys so that any one key only encrypts an appropriate amount of data.

Although biosecurity still relies on principles of prevention, disease-control programs focus more on limiting the extent and consequence of exposure. Many biosecurity measures aimed at preventing or eradicating epidemic disease also produce beneficial by-products, such as establishment of a firm foundation for control of erosive/endemic diseases and enhancement of host resistance through immunization.
