The Prelude of the Prelude and Fugue in A Minor, BWV 897 is now firmly attributed to Dretzel and it bears some clear parallels to the Toccata of BWV 565. The Prelude is the second movement of Dretzel's Divertimento Amonico in 3 movements, the manuscript of which was owned by Haydn.
